Local Careers News

I would like to share with you some employment statistics relating to the Humber region. As a school, we try to tailor our careers programme to include activity in sectors with demand. This allows students to upskill in areas of need and find out more about industries that will have employment opportunities locally. These figures were correct as of April 2018.

- The average income in Yorkshire and Humber is £26,105 per year
- 5% of people in Yorkshire and Humber are unemployed, this is slightly higher than the national average.
- It is predicted that there will be 86,000 more jobs in the area by 2022
- The sectors recruiting most now are Engineering, Hospitality, Health & Social Care and Finance.
- The sectors expected to recruit the most in the next few years are STEM, Skilled Construction, Business and Health & Social Care.
